## **Project Theme:**

I'm planning to do a series of themed shots using a Bokeh kit that was given to me as a Christmas present last year. We only briefly discussed it in class, but overall I know very little about executing a nice shot using the kit. I also have yet to use the kit, so this is a great opportunity to crack it open and learn to use it. I'd like to take this chance to familiarize myself with the technique and the best camera settings to master the perfect Bokeh shots. This would also involve playing with shots that have a shallow depth of field, focusing on a nearby subject while blurring the background to achieve the rounded-disc nature of the Bokeh. I'm hoping to produce about 10 (or more!) shots using various colors of light, shapes, and subjects in various environments.
